VIRGINIA REPUBLICAN CREED

We Believe:

Montgomery County Republican Party Plan (By-Laws)

Article III, Section F. Dues

- 1) Dues of the Unit Committee members are payable annually and are due at the time they are elected or re-elected at a mass meeting, or at such time as the Unit Committee votes to accept their membership. In the years in which no mass meeting election of members is held, dues are payable at the first Unit Committee meeting of the calendar year.
- 2) Unit Committee members shall automatically be dropped from membership if dues have not been paid after two Unit Committee meetings since the time dues were payable.
- 3) Dues shall be \$20.00 per year.

Article III, Section D.

- 2) Members of the Unit Committee shall be elected at a mass meeting for a two-year term. At any time during the Unit Committee term, it may elect new voting members by a majority vote at any duly called Unit Committee meeting where a quorum is present. Applications for membership shall **not** be voted on at the same meeting at which the application is received.
